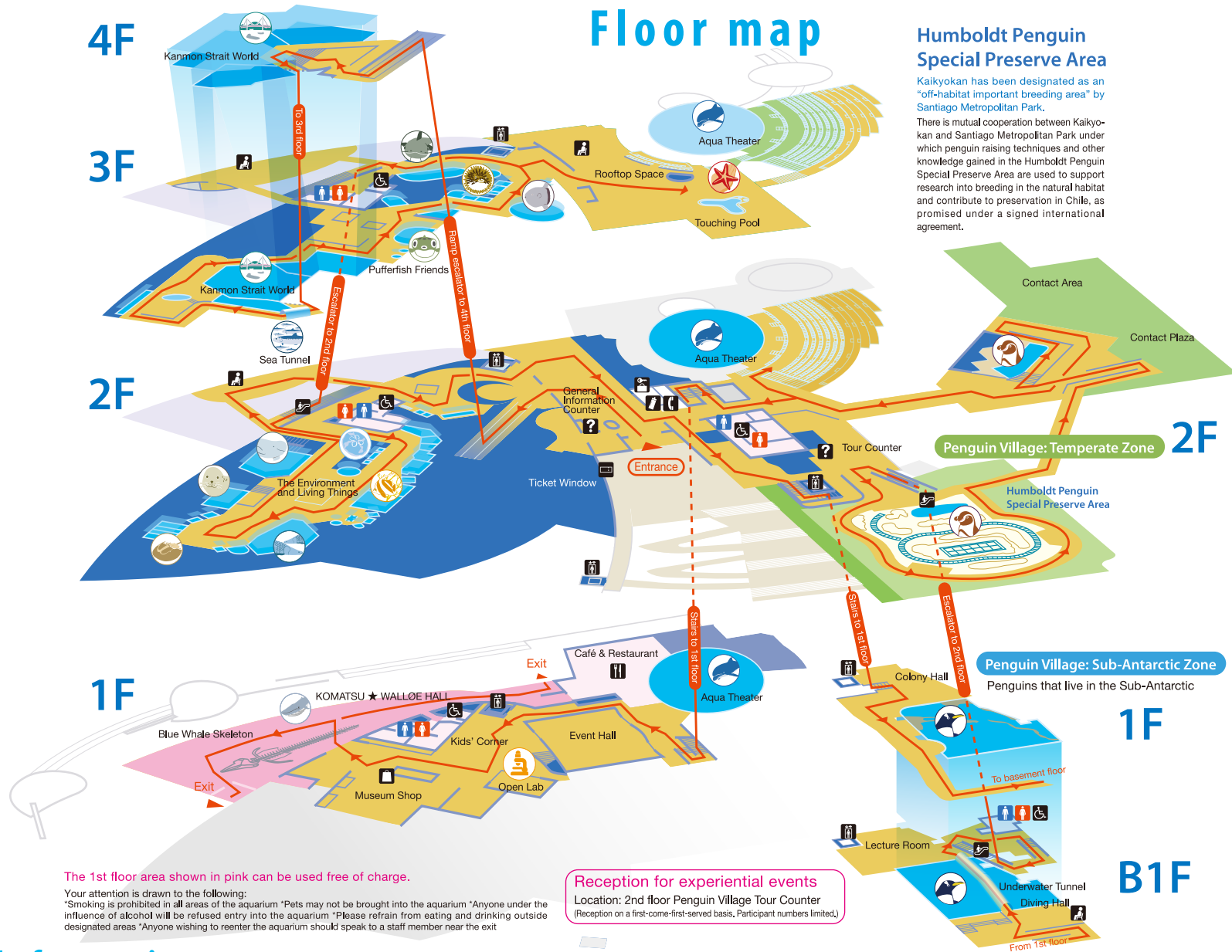


Floor map



Humboldt Penguin Special Preserve Area

Kaikyokan has been designated as an "off-habitat important breeding area" by Santiago Metropolitan Park. There is mutual cooperation between Kaikyokan and Santiago Metropolitan Park under which penguin raising techniques and other knowledge gained in the Humboldt Penguin Special Preserve Area are used to support research into breeding in the natural habitat and contribute to preservation in Chile, as promised under a signed international agreement.
